This Week: Saturday, June 29th, 2019 / Sunday, June 30th, 2019 13th Sunday in Ordinary Time **Reflections on Today's Readings:**

FOCUS: Jesus summons us to Him and then sends us out as messengers to proclaim His Kingdom. The Christian life is one of following the way of Christ. Jesus calls us out of our worldliness, out of our habits and attachments, to follow His way. And after we encounter the Lord, He sends us out to proclaim the truth of His Kingdom.

LITURGY OF THE WORD: In the reading from the First Book of Kings, the Lord tells Elijah to find Elisha and anoint him as prophet to succeed [him]. Elisha, though he wants to wait until he can say goodbye to his parents, nevertheless slaughters his oxen and follows. In the second reading, Paul writes to the Galatians about the freedom that Christ came to bring us which, if we live by the Spirit, allows us to not be controlled by the desires of the flesh. In the Gospel, Jesus is making His final journey to Jerusalem, and tells those who want to follow Him that they must do so without delay.





#### Did You Know?

Know the signs of a potential predator It's not always easy to spot someone who has malicious intentions towards children in your community. Although we have sex offender registries and certifications for adults who work with children, predators can slip through the cracks. Adults who are in regular contact with children - parents, grandparents, caregivers, etc. - should know the warning signs of a potential predator. Often, potential abusers will go overboard with touching children, wrestling, tickling, giving hugs and kisses. Other red flags including wanting to be alone with children or giving gifts, often without checking in with the parents first. # Fact of Life:

God Does Answer Prayers The following is an excerpt from Sean Carney, Director of 40 Days For Life. From one small vigil in College Station Texas in 2004, this peaceful, prayerful group has grown to an international phenomenon, resulting in the closing of hundreds of abortion facilities, and thousands of lives saved.

Planned Parenthood's landlord in Fayetteville, Arkansas was NOT a fan of 40 Days for Life. From baseless police calls to turning the sprinklers on vigil participants, he did whatever he could to make life difficult for 40 Days for Life volunteers. Sheila, the local campaign leader was frustrated and angry. But she never quit praying. ' had a prayer team dedicated to the landlord," she said. Slowly, things began to change. First, the landlord stunned the 40 Days for Life team when he welcomed a mobile ultrasound unit to park on the property. And then he made the decision not to renew Planned Parenthood's lease. He didn't have another tenant lined up to replace Planned Parenthood. Sheila said he simply realized that ending the lease with America's leading abortion provider was "the right thing to do."
