Seventh Sunday of Easter
Reflections on Today's Readings:

FOCUS: Jesus has prepared the way, and gives us the Holy Spirit to help us along. Occurring between the two other major feasts of Easter and Pentecost, the Ascension can be overlooked or lost. Perhaps today is a good day to reflect on what Jesus' return to the Father means to us: that he has fully prepared our way to the Father, and that we are never alone. The Holy Spirit is within us and around us as our Advocate.

LITURGY OF THE WORD: In the first reading, Luke recounts the many times that Jesus presented himself alive to his Apostles, his promise of the Holy Spirit to come, and Jesus' being *lifted up*, [where] a cloud took him from their sight. In the second reading, Paul prays that the Ephesians may have wisdom and knowledge of God through the power of the Holy Spirit. In the Gospel, Jesus tells his disciples that they are witnesses to the things that had been written and fulfilled. Then he blesses them and is *taken up to heaven*.

3-week Summer School Program for students entering Kinder-6th grade (in Fall 2019) from June 24-July 12, **NO SCHOOL JULY 4TH.**

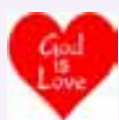
Classes are from 8:30-11:30 am.
