

<u>FOCUS</u>: Find us ready, Lord! Faithfully living the life of a disciple requires great trust in a God who can seem distant or even absent, depending on the circumstances of our lives. Sometimes we create the distance by giving priority to the distractions of the world, and sometimes tragic events beyond our control can cause us to doubt God's presence. The Mission Co-Op Collection takes place THIS weekend, August 10/11th, 2019

Today, Most Rev. Amal Raj, Bishop of Ootacamund, India is visiting our parish to make mission appeal for his diocese. This diocese was established in 1955 in the mountainous area of Tamil Nadu State in India by Pope Pious XII. It has a Catholic population of c.85,000 which would be 5% of the total population.

The diocese of Ootacamund spreads out in three districts namely Nilgiris, part of Erode and part of Coimbatore districts. About 150 priests and 415 religious serve in about 70 parishes and 22 high schools of this diocese. About two thirds of the faithful of the diocese of Ootacamund are mostly daily wages laborers and farmers. Apart from people with different cultures the diocese is endowed with different aboriginal tribes both in Nilgiris and Erode districts. The amount received from the mission appeals will be spent for the missionary works for the tribal people and for the education of their children.

DID YOU KNOW? Using vanishing communication technology to send harmful messages

From your cell phone you can send virtually any form of communication — even messages that disappear almost immediately after being sent. With apps like Snapchat and Instagram, or even some texting apps, children with social media accounts can communicate privately and secretively, sending messages and pictures that disappear after they are seen. Obviously, vanishing messages pose a problem, as parents can't monitor what their children are saying or receiving. Check your child's phone for these apps and talk about the importance of transparency and honesty. It's also important for children to know that even a "vanishing" message can be saved through a screenshot.
