

THIS WEEK: SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 15TH/ SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 16TH, 2020 SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME REFLECTIONS ON TODAY'S READINGS:

<u>FOCUS</u>: Jesus came to fulfill the law so that heaven could be opened to the righteous. Jesus' teachings are not primarily about the joys and easiness of the Christian life, but rather about the commandments that our loving Father gives to us for our freedom and good. He, who is perfect love, made us in love and sent his Son out of love to teach us what it means to partake in his life — both here and forever.

<u>LITURGY OF THE WORD</u>: In the first reading, Sirach tells the people they can choose to follow the commandments, or not. But keeping the commandments will save them. In Saint Paul's Letter to the Corinthians, he writes of the greatness prepared for those who love God. In the Gospel from Matthew. Jesus teaches about the law. He says that he has come to fulfill the law, and that those who keep it will be called the greatest in the kingdom of heaven.

ASH WEDNESDAY MARKS THE BEGINNING OF LENT.

ASH WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 26th, 2020

MASSES; 6:30 AM, 8 AM, 11 AM, & 6 PM



The Catholic Community around the world follows these general regulations during Lent: <u>ABSTINENCE</u> – Refrain from the consumption of meat. This penitential practice is to be observed by all Catholics who are 14 years of age and older. Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and the Fridays

during Lent are days of abstinence. Pastors and parents are encouraged to see that children who are not bound by the obligation to fast and abstain are led to appreciate an authentic sense of penance. <u>FASTING AND ABSTINENCE</u> – Fasting is observed on Ash Wednesday & Good Friday by all Catholics between the ages of 18-59 years (inclusive). On days of fasting, one full meal is allowed. Two smaller meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids are allowed. If a person is unable to observe the above regulations due to ill health or other serious reasons, they are urged to practice other forms of self-denial that are suitable to their condition. Giving up something for Lent fosters self-discipline and tempers our desires. It is a form of fasting. It is a form of penance. It promotes spiritual growth. If you're giving up something for Lent, that's great. Also consider doing something positive to bolster your spiritual life and make the world a better place. Look for ways that you can increase your knowledge of your faith, strengthen your spiritual life or perform special acts of mercy and kindness at home, at work, in your parish or in your community. Strengthen your faith!

Did You Know? Make a playground checklist

Parents sometimes think of playgrounds as "drop zones" for their kids—keep an eye or an ear out, but otherwise settle in on a bench while your child burns off energy. Nearly 170,000 children were injured on playgrounds in 2019, and a few moments of careful attention could keep your child from joining those ranks. When you get to a playground, check out the surfaces underneath the equipment, especially equipment that allows children to jump or hang from it. The ground surface should be soft and shock absorbent.
