

# THIS WEEK: SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 29th/SUNDAY, MARCH 1st, 2020 FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT REFLECTIONS ON TODAY'S READINGS:

<u>EOCUS</u>: The season of Lent calls us to humility, to an honest understanding of who we are. Humility is not false modesty, but the awareness of who we are: Sons and daughters of God, created by God. Yet we, like Adam and Eve, are often tempted to think of ourselves as more than creatures, as in control of the world. May God give us the grace to allow Him to be God.

<u>LITURGY OF THE WORD</u>: In the first reading, the woman and her husband eat fruit from the tree of life, and realize they are naked. In the Letter to **the Romans, Paul reassures us that God's grace surpasses any of our sins. In the Gospel, the devil tempts Jesus while He is in the desert, but Jesus says to him,** *Get away, Satan***! and the devil leaves Him.**

Lent 2020 – The Catholic Community around the world follows these general regulations

during Lent: <u>ABSTINENCE</u> – Refrain from the consumption of meat. This penitential practice is to be observed by all Catholics who are 14 years of age and older. Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and the Fridays during Lent are days of abstinence. Pastors and parents are encouraged to see that children who are not bound by the obligation to fast and abstain are led to appreciate an authentic sense of penance.

FASTING AND ABSTINENCE – Fasting is observed on Ash Wednesday & Good Friday by all
Catholics between the ages of 18-59 years (inclusive). On days of fasting, one full meal is allowed. Two smaller meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids are allowed. If a person is unable to observe the above regulations due to ill health or other serious reasons, they are urged to practice other forms of self-denial that are suitable to their condition. Giving up something for Lent fosters self-discipline and tempers our desires. It is a form of fasting. It is a form of penance. It promotes spiritual growth. If you're giving up something for Lent, that's great. Also consider

doing something positive to bolster your spiritual life and make the world a better place. Look for ways that you can increase your knowledge of your faith, strengthen your spiritual life or perform special acts of mercy and kindness at home, at work, in your parish or in your community. **Strengthen your faith!**
