FACTS OF LIFE

Major milestone: Four million have received tangible help thanks to pro-life hotline

Heartbeat International has announced a major milestone for OptionLine, the organization's "pro-life contact center providing round-the-clock support for women and families in need" who are experiencing unplanned pregnancies. According to an emailed press release, this week, the "only fully staffed, 24/7 bilingual pro-life contact center in the United States, served its 4-millionth client with life-saving assistance and resources."

The four-millionth call was received on August 24th from India, and "a seasoned consultant... helped the client sort through her concerns and find pregnancy help near her area via Heartbeat International's Worldwide Directory of Pregnancy Help."

The consultant who served the client commented that her motivation to serve others comes from her own personal experience with an unplanned pregnancy. "Because of my life experiences I can relate to young women in crisis. I wouldn't want any other job!" she said. www.liveaction.org

Cyberbullying is still a threat with distance learning

This year, with school starting online, children of all ages will be interacting with one another via technology, even more than usual. Be on the lookout for signs that bullying is happening via the internet, texting, various apps, or social media – as challenging as it is, monitor both the amount of time your children are "plugged in" and the content of what they are doing, when interacting with their peers. Cyberbullying can include the use of apps, texts, photographs, and images that are intended to hurt, harass, embarrass, or even destroy the reputation of a victim. Unlike at school, you cannot walk away from cyberbullying – it spreads instantly, 24/7. Children who are cyberbullied may avoid going online or talking to their so-called friends. MEMORIAL OF OUR LADY OF SORROWS - SEPTEMBER 15th

Devotion to the Seven Sorrows (dolors or sorrow, grief, pain) of Our Lady has its roots in Holy Scripture, which associates the Blessed Mother with her suffering Son.

In Luke chapter 2:34, Mary and Joseph bring the infant to be blessed in the Temple, in Jerusalem. He was presented to Simeon, and he blessed Jesus and then turned to Mary, his mother and said, “Behold, this child is set for the fall and rising of many in Israel, and for a sign that is spoken against (and a sword will pierce through your own soul also), that thoughts out of many hearts may be relieved.” If the Church limits the number of sorrows to seven, it is because this number has always symbolized the idea of totality and universality. In 1482, this feast was added to the Missal under the title of **“Our Lady of Compassion.”** Pope Benedict XIII, added it to the Roman Calendar in 1727, on the Friday before Palm Sunday. Then, in the 1800’s, the Servite and Cistercian Monks began to reintroduce and promote this Feast Day of Mary.

It was celebrated as “The Seven Dolors,” referring to the seven swords, that pierced the heart of Mary. Many paintings, show Mary with seven swords piercing her heart. During this time, Rome was seized by France, and Napoleon declared the Papal City as part of France. Pius VII excommunicated the invaders but then was taken prisoner until 1814, when France was invaded by Papal allies. During this time in captivity, the Pope prayed fervently to Our Lady and was released in 5 years with Mary’s intercession. This prompted Pius VII to extend this feast day to the Universal Church.

Then, about one hundred years later, Pope Pius X, in 1913, fixed the date to September 15. The title “Our Lady of Sorrows” focused on Mary’s intense suffering, during the passion and death of Christ. The feast, is like the Octave of Mary’s birthday, that we celebrate on September 8.

As Mary stood at the foot of the Cross, on which Jesus hung, the swords of sorrows Simeon had foretold, pierced her soul. Abbot Prosper Gueranger, a Benedictine monk from the 1800’s, believed that “it is in sorrow that our fortitude is tested. As so, we should understand that when difficulties, bad health, and conflicts.....visit us, we must not see them as things that should never happen. To suffer is normal in this vale of tears. If Mary, whom God loves so much, suffered, how much more should we suffer. He, who God and Our Lady love, suffers because God will not refuse to give him

that which, He gave abundantly to the two whom He loved most: Our Lord, Jesus Christ and Our Lady.

Below are the seven sorrows of Mary.

1. The prophecy of Simeon
2. The flight into Egypt
3. Loss of the Child Jesus for 3 days
4. Mary meets Jesus on His way to Calvary
5. Crucifixion and Death of Jesus
6. The body of Jesus taken from the Cross
7. The burial of Jesus




Our Blessed Mother revealed these 7 promises to St. Bridget of Sweden, in the 14th Century. Our Lady said, she would bestow seven graces to those souls honoring her daily, by saying 7 Hail Marys, while meditating on her tears and sorrows.

1. “I will grant peace to the family”.
2. “They will be enlightened about the Divine Mysteries”.
3. “I will console them in their pains and I will accompany them in their work.”
4. “I will give them as much as they ask, for as long as it does not oppose the adorable will of my Divine Son or the sanctification of their souls.”
5. “I will defend them in their spiritual battles with the infernal enemy and I will protect them at every instant of their lives.”
6. “I will visible help them at the moment of their death- they will see the face of their mother.”
7. “I have obtained this grace from my Divine Son, that those who propagate this devotion to my tears and dolors, will be taken directly from this earthly life to eternal happiness, since all their sins will be forgotten and my Son will be their eternal consolation and joy.”

Patron: people named Dolores, Dolais, Deloris, Dolorita, Maria Dolorosa, Pia & Pieta.

Symbols: Heart pierced with a sword or 7 swords, red rose, iris (meaning: sword-lily), cyclamen.

♥ The Power of The Rosary Our Lady's 15 Promises for Praying the Rosary



7. Whoever shall have a true devotion for the Rosary shall not die without the Sacraments of the Church. This promise highlights the benefits of obtaining the most possible Graces at the hour of death via the Sacraments of Confession, Eucharist, and Extreme Unction (Anointing of the Sick). Being properly disposed while receiving these Sacraments near death ensures one’s salvation (although perhaps with a detour through Purgatory) since a final repentance is possible.

8. Those who are faithful to recite the Rosary shall have during their life and at their death the Light of God and the plenitude of His Graces; at the moment of death they shall participate in the Merits of the Saints in Paradise. Our Lady highlights the great quantity of Graces obtain through praying the Rosary, which assist us during life and at the moment of death. The merits of the Saints are the gift of God’s rewards to those persons who responded to His Grace that they obtained during life, and so Our Lady indicates that She will provide a share of that to us at death. With this promise and #7 above, Our Lady is providing the means for the person to have a very holy death.


