Twenty-sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time ~ FAMILIAR INSIGHTS

Spiritual teachers tend to repeat themselves, and to repeat other teachers. Maybe there really aren't that many different truths to tell. Just a lot of slow, sleepy human beings—like us—who need to hear the basics over and over. Consider today's readings. People complain God isn't "fair," and Ezekiel answers that God is more than fair. People choose their own fates, and people can change. Even evildoers can turn, do right, and live. "Actions speak louder than words." A fresh new insight? Hardly. Paul tells the Philippians that he would truly be encouraged if those who claimed to be believers would, in fact, look to others' interests and not their own. "The proof of the pudding is in the eating." A novel idea? I don't think so. In Jesus' story of the farmer and his sons, everyone knows that the one who said he wouldn't work—but did—is way ahead of the one who said he would work—but didn't. "Talk is cheap." Heard that before?

Q: Why is October referred to as the Month of the Rosary?

A: The answer to this question is relatively simple, but needs a historical context in order to be fully appreciated. The short answer is this: [October is dedicated as the Month of the Rosary because we celebrate the memorial of Our Lady of the Rosary each year on October 7](#). To understand this feast, we need to go back in time. In the 16th century, the Islamic Ottoman Empire presented a serious military threat to western Europe and sent a fleet of ships to attack Christian defenses in southern Europe. Pope Pius V, recognized the grave danger and organized a fleet, called the Holy League, to confront the navy of the Ottoman Turks. On October 7, 1571, the two navies engaged in a pivotal battle that would determine who controlled maritime traffic in the Mediterranean, Adriatic, and Aegean seas. The fate of western Europe depended upon the success of Christians in this navy battle, which involved more than 400 warships. (This was the largest naval battle in Western history for centuries). Pius V, knew he needed more than just military strength to defend Christian Europe, so he asked that all the faithful pray the rosary, requesting the intercession of the Blessed Mother. At the end of the Battle of Lepanto, the Holy League was victorious and the maritime expansion of the Ottoman Empire was permanently prevented. The next year, Pius V, established a Feast on October 7 in honor of the Blessed Mother, originally called Our Lady of Victory. After a few centuries, the name was changed to Our Lady of the Rosary, to more clearly recognize that prayer was the greatest power at work that day on the seas.

Two-year-old Ezekiel, a survivor of two attempted abortions, sings praises to God

Eric and Mandy Godwin wanted to share the faith and joy of their adopted son Ezekiel — an abortion survivor — with their friends and church members. But now, the video of the sweet two-year-old singing along to a Christian worship song has gone viral on Facebook, amassing more than two million views. Ezekiel is one of six children — three biological and three adopted. His mother Mandy founded and ran a pro-life pregnancy center for five years, and his father, Eric, is a pastor. Ezekiel is baby number five for the couple, and as Mandy said in the Facebook post featuring the video, “he survived not one, but two attempted abortions.” There’s a lot of Ezekiel’s story that his family doesn’t know. He was just two days old when they brought him home, and what little information they discovered in the paperwork, included that his birth mother had tried to self-abort him twice at home.

Did You Know?

Words can be warning signs of abuse

Many children will be learning in their own homes this fall, but that does not mean they will be fully protected from abuse. Sadly, most children are abused by someone considered to be a “known and trusted” person – that person may be a family member – even someone living in the same house as the child. Pay attention to the conversations your children are having, as words can be indicators that a child is being groomed or harmed. If your child or their friend(s) seem to “know” more about sexual topics than would be expected for their age, or seems unusually focused on such topics, it could be an indicator that something inappropriate and harmful is happening. FEAST OF THE ARCHANGELS MICHAEL, GABRIEL & RAPHAEL, SEPTEMBER 29th

In the liturgy, angels are memorialized on September 29, especially, the Archangels Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael. They are the only angels named in Scripture. The name "angel" is taken from a translation of a Hebrew word meaning "messenger."

According to Scripture (Col. 1:16; Eph. 1:21), there are three hierarchies of angels, each containing three orders, making nine classifications in all. The first three are the Seraphim, Cherubim, and Thrones; the second order are the Dominations, Principalities, and Powers; the third order are the Virtues, Archangels, and Angels. The Guardian Angels are all chosen from this last Order of Angels.

Angels are immortal beings, whose role is to minister to God and to obey the will of God. They are bodiless, and their knowledge comes through intuition, not through senses, like man. While much is hidden from them, they understand and know much more than man. They can move swiftly, have free will, and communicate among themselves.

Archangel Michael is not a saint. He is an angel, who is the leader of all angels and the Army of God. The title "Archangel" means that he is above all others within his rank. Michael is sometimes referred to as the Warrior Angel.

The word Michael means "who is like God?" or referred to as "Prince of the Heavenly Host." Michael has four main responsibilities or tasks, as we have learned through Scripture and through tradition.

- * The first is to combat Lucifer (aka) Satan or the devil.
- * The second is to escort the faithful to heaven at the hour of their death.
- * The third is to be the champion of all Christians, and the Church itself.
- * And the fourth is to call men from life on Earth to their heavenly judgement at the end of time

Michael is named twice in the Book of Daniel. Once, when he helped Daniel in the lion's den and second, in regard to the end of times, when he will stand for the "chidden of thy people." In the Epistle of St. Jude, Michael guards the tombs of Moses and Eve and must fight with Satan over the body of Moses. He is mentioned in Revelations when Michael and his angels battle with the dragon. He acts as a superhero or protector.

Michael the Archangel is Patron of: The Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist, soldiers, police officers, doctors, grocers, mariners, and military personnel

Archangel Gabriel means, "God is my strength" or "God has shown Himself mightily." Gabriel appears in the Bible four times. The Archangel appears to Daniel twice. Daniel prays on behalf of the people of Israel. As soon as Daniel

begins praying, God sends Gabriel to answer him. "At the beginning of your supplication, a word went forth, and I have come to tell it to you." (Dn 9:23) God had also sent Gabriel to Daniel, after he had a dream and needed some explanation of his vision of the ram and the goat. (Dn.18:16-26)

Of course, the next two events with the angel are very special. Gabriel appeared first to Zechariah, to tell him that he and Elizabeth would have a son, and they shall call him John. Then it is Gabriel, who tells the Blessed Virgin Mary, that she is to become the mother of the Messiah, saying to her, "Rejoice, O highly favored daughter! The Lord is with you. Blessed are you among women." (Lk.1:28)

Gabriel the Archangel is Patron of: The Sacrament of Baptism, conception, pregnancies, and births; broadcasters, and anyone involved with communication such as mail carriers, radio, TV, and parish office administrators,

Archangel Raphael: In the Old Testament, Book of Tobias, which was written in about 200 B.C., it tells the story of Asmodeus, an evil spirit. As the story goes, he fell in love with Sarah, the only daughter of Raquel Ecbatan. Asmodeus slays the 7 successive husbands of Sarah on their wedding night. His power over her is broken by Tobias, but only with the help of Azarias. In Hebrew, Azarias means "Yahweh helps." It is believed that Azarias, was the Archangel Raphael, who took on the disguise of a human, and traveled with Tobias on his adventures. He helped Tobias brew a potion, which drove Asmodeus away.

The name Raphael means, "God's healer." Raphael is recorded to have made a balm or ointment from fish, to cure Tobias' father's blindness and cured Jacob's disjoined thigh. Because of his favorable companionship with Tobias, he is considered the most sociable of the Archangels with, probably, the best sense of humor and happiest of dispositions. It is said that, "Raphael delights in bringing health and happiness everywhere he goes." He is also called the Angel of Science and Knowledge.

Raphael the Archangel is Patron of: The Sacrament of Reconciliation, Christian marriages, Catholic studies, travelers, nurses, physicians, and medical scientists.



♥ The Power of The Rosary Our Lady's 15 Promises for Praying the Rosary

11. You shall obtain all you ask of me by recitation of the Rosary. This promise emphasizes Our Lady's role as our Advocate and Mediatrix of all Graces. Of course, all requests are subject to God's Most Perfect Will. God will always grant our request if it is beneficial for our soul, and Our Lady will only intercede for us when our request is good for our salvation. (see [Lumen Gentium chapter VIII - Our Lady #62](#)).
12. All those who propagate the Holy Rosary shall be aided by me in their necessities. If one promotes the praying of the Rosary, Our Lady emphasizes Her Maternal care for us by obtaining many Graces (i.e. spiritual necessities) and also material necessities (neither excess nor luxury), all subject to the Will of God of course.

Thérèse of Lisieux, born Marie Françoise Thérèse Martin, also known as Saint Thérèse of the Child Jesus and the Holy Face, was a French Catholic Discalced Carmelite nun who is widely venerated in modern times. She is popularly known as "The Little Flower of Jesus", or simply "The Little Flower."



Generations of Catholics have admired this young Saint, called the "Little Flower," and found in her short life more inspiration for their own lives than in volumes by theologians. Yet, Therese died when she was 24, after having lived as a cloistered Carmelite for less than ten years. She never went on missions, never founded a religious order, and never performed great works. The only book of hers, published after her death, was a brief edited version of her journal called, "Story of a Soul." (Collections of her letters and restored versions of her journals have been published recently.) But, within 28 years of her death, the public demand was so great that she was canonized. She worried about her vocation: "I feel in me the vocation of the Priest. I have the vocation of the Apostle. Martyrdom was the dream of my youth and this dream has grown with me. Considering the mystical body of the Church, I desired to see myself in them all. Charity gave me the key to my vocation. I understood that the Church had a Heart and that this Heart was burning with love. I understood that Love comprised all vocations, that Love was everything, that it embraced all times and places...in a word, that it was eternal! Then in the excess of my delirious joy, I cried out: O Jesus, my Love...my vocation, at last I have found it...My vocation is Love!"


