In the final verses of today's Gospel reading Jesus says that when two or three are gathered in his name, "there am I in the midst of them" (Matthew 18:20). Sister who addressed RNC is a doctor
who provides abortion pill reversal

The religious sister, capturing headlines for her powerful pro-life witness at the Republican National Convention (RNC) Wednesday night, is also a medical provider with the Abortion Pill Rescue Network (APRN). **Sister Beirdre “Dede” Byrne, POSC, an MD,** made remarkable statements in support of life during her address, about when life begins, how the unborn are marginalized, and the need to stand up for life, despite the political correctness of today. She also made the crucial point that life is not just about living on this earth. “As a physician, I can say without hesitation: Life begins at conception,” she said. “While what I have to say may be difficult for some to hear, I am saying it because I’m not just pro-life, I’m pro-eternal life. I want all of us to end up in heaven together someday.” Byrne, a general surgeon, retired U.S. Army colonel and missionary, also puts her pro-life convictions into action in her local community, by ministering to women facing unplanned pregnancies and offering a second chance at life, through abortion pill reversal.

Saint Anastasia was born in 281 A.D. and became a perfect symbol of peace, humanity, and solidarity. Her Feast Day is December 25th. She is a symbol of dialogue and collaboration. In her spirit, and in the spirit of love, we welcome all to the Catholic Community of St. Anastasia Catholic Church.

THE NATIVITY OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY - SEPTEMBER 8th

The Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary or the birth of the Virgin Mary refers to our Catholic Feast Day celebrating the birth of Mary, Mother of Jesus. **The Church has celebrated Mary's birth since at least the sixth century.** A September birth was chosen because the Feast of the Immaculate Conception is on December 8, nine months prior to her birthday. On December 8, 1854, Pope Pius IX, formally confirmed the faith of the people of God in Mary's Immaculate Conception, and defined as a Doctrine, the fact that Mary "in the first instance of her conception, was preserved, exempt from all stain of original sin."

This, of course, meant that Original Sin was never part of Mary, and therefore she remained sinless her whole life. But, she was not released from the effects of Original Sin, for we know she suffered greatly. Pope Pius IX tells that this gift was granted to Mary, not because she earned it or deserved it, but it was a gift from God, in view of the merits of His Son, **Jesus Christ. It was God's way of preparing Mary for her life's mission as mother of Jesus, His Son.**

St. James fills in the account of Mary's birth, since it is not mentioned in Scripture. James tells us that Anna and Joachim were infertile, but prayed for a child. **They received the promise of a child, who would advance God's plan of salvation for the world.** Such a story, stresses the special presence of **God in Mary's life from the very beginning.**

St. Augustine connects Mary's birth with Jesus' saving work. He tells the world to rejoice and shine forth in the light of her birth.

"She is the flower of the field from whom bloomed the precious lily of the valley. Through her birth, the nature inherited from our first parents (Adam and Eve) is changed."

The opening prayer at Mass speaks of the birth of Mary's Son, as the dawn of our salvation, and asks for an increase of peace. Every human birth, as a call for new hope in the world. The love of two human beings has joined with God in his creative work. The loving parents have shown hope in a world filled with problems. The new child has the potential to be **a channel of God's love and peace to the world.**

This is all true in a magnificent way, in Mary. If Jesus is the perfect expression of God's love, **Mary is the foreshadowing of that love.** If Jesus has brought the fullness of salvation, Mary is its dawning.

Birthday celebrations bring happiness to the guest of honor, as well as,

to family and friends. **Next to the birth of Jesus, Mary's birth offers the greatest possible happiness to the world.** Each time we celebrate her birth, we can confidently hope for an increase of peace, in our hearts and in the world at large.

Since September 8th marks the end of summer and beginning of fall, there are many thanksgiving celebrations and customs attached to it around the world.

The winegrowers in France call this feast, "Our Lady of the Grape Harvest." The best grapes were brought to the local churches and blessed, then branches were attached to the statue of Mary. There was a large festival that followed.

In the Austrian Alps, this is "Drive-Down-Day," when the cattle and sheep are led to the slopes into the valley, where they will spend winter. Festivities follow, and milk and leftover food is given to the poor in honor of **Our Lady's Nativity.**

On Our Lady's birthday, the Church celebrates the first dawning of redemption, with the appearance in the world, of the Savior's mother, Mary. The Blessed Mother occupies a unique place in the history of salvation, and she has the highest mission ever given to any creature. We rejoice that the Mother of God is our mother, too! Let us often, call upon the Blessed Virgin as **"CAUSE OF OUR JOY," one of the most beautiful titles given to Our Lady.**

Our Lady's 15 Promises for Praying the Rosary

5. The soul which recommends itself to me by the recitation of the Rosary shall not perish. Since Our Lady is our Mother and Advocate, She always assists those who call on Her implicitly by praying the Rosary. The Church reminds us of this in the Memorare prayer, "... never was it known that anyone who fled to your protection, implored your help or sought your intercession, was left unaided ..."

6. Whosoever shall recite the Rosary devoutly, applying himself to the consideration of its Sacred Mysteries shall never be conquered by misfortune. God will not chastise him in His justice, he shall not perish by an unprovided death; if he be just he shall remain in the grace of God, and become worthy of Eternal Life. This promise highlights the magnitude of Graces that the Rosary brings to whomever prays it. One will draw down God's Mercy rather than His Justice and will have a final chance to repent (see promise #7). One will not be conquered by misfortune means that Our Lady will obtain for the person sufficient Graces to handle said misfortune (i.e. carry the Crosses allowed by God) without falling into despair. As Sacred Scripture tells us, "For my yoke is sweet and my burden light." (Matthew 11:30) - TO BE CONTINUED...

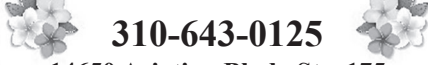
