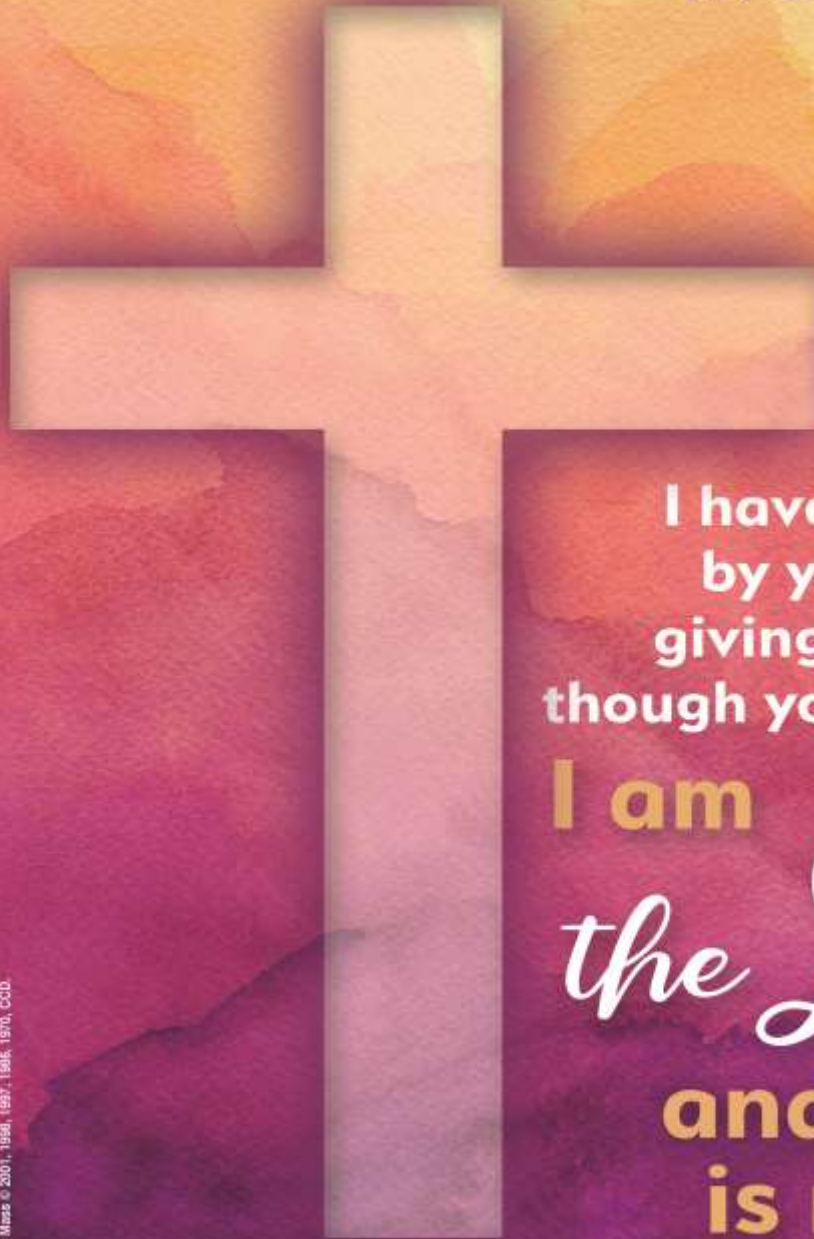

Twenty-ninth Sunday in Ordinary Time ~ IN GOD ALONE ~ ~

Isaiah speaks to us today of Cyrus, King of Persia, anointed by the Lord. God calls Cyrus by name and leads him in service to the Israelites. In this passage we hear that it is the Lord who gives Cyrus his title, who arms him against his enemies, and who opens doors and unbars gates before him. And God does all of this so that the people will know that **"I am the LORD,"** and that **"there is none besides me"** (Isaiah 45:6). Paul opens his letter with essentially the same notion—that in God alone we find our grace and peace. Paul also gives thanks to God on our behalf, calling to mind our work of faith, hope, and love. And in the familiar Gospel reading, Jesus tells the Pharisees to give to Caesar what is Caesar's and to God what is God's.

FACTS OF LIFE: Twin Brothers Become Priests After Their Mother Rejects Abortion

Twin brothers who both became priests are reaching thousands of people with the message of God's truth after their mother chose life for them in difficult circumstances nearly 40 years ago. [Aleteia reports](#) Fathers Paulo and Felipe Lizama have active ministries both in person and online in the Catholic Diocese of Valparaiso in their native Chile, and they credit it, in part, to their mother's trust in God. Their mother, Rosa Silva, was encouraged to abort her twin sons after doctors thought that they detected a fetal abnormality, possibly conjoined twins, during an ultrasound appointment, according to the report. Silva said she also was told that her pregnancy could be life threatening. Refusing to give up hope, Silva said she decided to accept "whatever God sends me" and chose life for her sons. Whether the doctors were wrong or God worked a miracle, the family does not know: but on Sept. 10, 1984, both twins were born healthy, the report states. "I always feel special affection and tenderness when I think of the heart of my mother, who was willing to give her life for me; for us," Paulo said. www.lifenews.com

Saint Anastasia was born in 281 A.D. and became a perfect symbol of peace, humanity, and solidarity. Her Feast Day is December 25th. She is a symbol of dialogue and collaboration. In her spirit, and in the spirit of love, we welcome all to the Catholic Community of St. Anastasia Catholic Church.

SAINT JOHN OF CAPISTRANO , FEAST DAY, OCTOBER 23rd

In 1386, St. John was born in Capistrano, Italy, in the Kingdom of Naples. He was the son of a former German knight in that same city. John lost his father, at a very young age, but his mother made sure he was well educated. After learning Latin, he studied at the University of Perugia, in central Italy. He studied both Civil and Church Law and practiced as a lawyer in the Courts of Naples. He became a very prominent figure and was appointed Governor of Perugia at age 26.

John had very high standards of integrity and worked hard to end a war between Perugia and the House of Malatesta. During this war he was betrayed, captured by the enemy, and imprisoned. When in prison, he began to question where he was going with his life. He faced St. Francis of Assisi in a dream and resolved to embrace poverty, chastity, and obedience with the Franciscan Monks.

When released from prison, in October 1416, John gave up all his social status and possessions and joined the Franciscans. His mentor was St. Bernadine of Siena. He was well known for his bold teaching and prayer, focused on the name of Jesus. John took after his teacher and began teaching as a deacon in 1420. He was ordained a priest, five years later. John successfully defended his mentor from a charge of heresy, made against his way of devotion. More than one Pope entrusted John to try and reunite Eastern and Western Christendom at the Ecumenical Council of Florence.

John was a brilliant preacher and traveled

throughout Italy, Germany, Bohemia, Austria, Hungary, Poland, and Russia preaching penance. The Churches could not accommodate the crowds. They gathered in fields and public squares to hear him preach. At times, there were 50,000, 80,000 or over 100,000 people that listened to his sermons. He performed many miracles by healing the sick.

When Mohammed II was threatening Vienna and Rome, St. John, at the age of 70, was commissioned by Pope Callistus III to preach and lead a crusade against the invading Turks. Marching at the head of 70,000 Christians, with his friend Janos Hunyadi, he became victorious, in the great Battle of Belgrade in 1456. Winning this battle, against the Ottoman Empire, helped to preserve his title as "Soldier Priest."

Hunyadi became sick and died soon after this victory at Belgrade. John survived to preach at Hunyadi's funeral sermon, but soon after, the bubonic plague took his life on October 23, 1456 in Ilok, Hungary. He was canonized in 1690 by Pope Alexander VIII.

John is the namesake of the Franciscan Missions, San Juan Capistrano in Southern California and San Juan Capistrano Mission in San Antonio, Texas. St. John of Capistrano is Patron Saint of: Belgrade, Hungary, Military Chaplains, Judges, Lawyers, and Jurists.
