## Twenty-seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time ~ THE GIFT OF THE REIGN OF GOD

Matthew's Gospel today expands on Isaiah's ballad considerably. A comparison with the same story in Mark's Gospel clearly shows us that here the author is busy teaching this community of Jewish Christians: "This is a story about Israel a long time ago; this is also a story about Jesus and the skeptical leaders." Jesus as much as told these Jewish leaders that they were the tenants who first stoned their own prophets. And he told the leaders they were the tenants who would soon even dispose of him—Jesus—and, in doing so, would forfeit their privileged place of presenting to the world the promised Messiah. "And this," says Matthew's Gospel, "is a story about you, the inheritors of what was first offered to Israel." The reign of God was first opened to Israel and is now given to the whole world, but it must be received as a gift. The first Christians are the new tenants in the vineyard. The deeper reality of the reign or kingdom of God is that it is available to everyone on the face of the earth—Israel included.

### FACTS OF LIFE

**The Knights of Columbus announced a "Novena for the Cause of Life" as part of Respect Life Month, observed in October.**

The novena will take place Oct. 4-12. Each day of the novena will include a decade of the rosary, a reflection on a quote from Pope Francis, and a closing prayer to Mary taken from *Evangelium vitae*, St. John Paul II's 1995 encyclical on the value and inviolability of human life. "The Knights wish to join all Catholics in prayer with Pope Francis for an end to abortion, euthanasia and the many social ills that bring illness, broken families, unhappiness and premature death, especially for the vulnerable." The Church in the United States celebrates Respect Life Month in October and the first Sunday is observed as Respect Life Sunday. During the month, the Church asks Catholics to reflect on the dignity of the person and to take action to spread the pro-life message. "The theme of this year's national observance, 'Live the Gospel of Life,' says that, with Christ, we are meant to enjoy and foster life, the gift of being fully alive."

The social media site TikTok has exploded in popularity during the coronavirus pandemic, with children and adults using it to connect and pass time while in quarantine. Unfortunately, apps like TikTok are often targeted by predators as easy ways to get in touch with vulnerable children. TikTok has "Family Pairing" capabilities, which allow parents to set restrictions on their children's usage. Saint Anastasia was born in 281 A.D. and became a perfect symbol of peace, humanity, and solidarity. Her Feast Day is December 25th. She is a symbol of dialogue and collaboration. In her spirit, and in the spirit of love, we welcome all to the Catholic Community of St. Anastasia Catholic Church.

## SAINT MARIA FAUSTINA , FEAST DAY, OCTOBER 5th

She was born Helena Kowalska, on August 25, 1905 in Glogowiec County, Poland. She was the third child of ten, coming from a poor peasant family with very religious parents, Stanislaus and Marianna.

She wanted to enter the convent at age 12, after finishing only three years of education. Her parents would not give their permission. At age 16, she went to work as a housekeeper in Lodi and Ostrowek in order to have money to support herself and help support her parents. Through her youth, Helena, was very pious and had much compassion for the poor and suffering. Once, while still a young teenager, Helena reached out to a homeless man living in a small place below the stairs where she worked. She brought a priest one day to hear his confession and give him Communion. Helena was happy she was able to help the man be reunited with God, because he died the next day. She always wanted to bring people to God.

She still wanted to join the convent and was called by a vision of the "Suffering Christ" to enter the Congregation of the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy, at age 20, and she took the name of Sister Maria Faustina. She lived with the sisters for 13 years and worked as their cook and gardener. She contemplated the mystery of God's mercy, everyday in her routine, monotonous life. Perhaps this is why the Lord decided that she should be the one to carry out His Divine Mercy message.

The Diary of St. Maria Faustina Kowalska: Divine Mercy in My Soul (730 pages) is the book that Faustina wrote that started the message and devotion to the Divine Mercy. It details St. Faustina's amazing encounter with the Divine Mercy-Our Lord Jesus Christ. On February 22, 1931 Jesus appeared to her as the "King of Divine Mercy" and was robed in a white garment. He asked Faustina to have the vision painted exactly as she saw it, with one hand raised in blessing and the other upon His heart and two rays flowing from His chest. One is red, to signify the blood of Jesus and the other is white as a symbol of water that saves souls. Faustina describes God's love as

a "Fountain of Mercy". Faustina was not satisfied with her artwork, and God said He would send help. Soon, Faustina was sent to a convent in Vilnius to work as a gardener. There, she met Fr. Michael Sopocko, the confessor for the nuns. He introduced Faustina to the artist Eugene Kazimierowski, who painted the first image of Divine Mercy for Saint Faustina. The image mostly used in Churches today can be seen at our Church, St. Anastasia's on the left side of the altar.

Faustina had many other visions. She saw visions of Heaven, where all creatures give praise to God. She saw visions of souls suffering in Hell and the mercy of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

On September 13, 1935 she had another vision, and the next day a voice taught her to say a prayer on ordinary rosary beads: This is called The Divine Chaplet. It has been a tradition at St. Anastasia's to have weekly devotions on Wednesday nights, when the Divine Chaplet is recited during the Exposition of the Holy Eucharist. Many promises are granted to those who honor the Chaplet of Divine Mercy.

St. Faustina died on October 5, 1938, age 33. Within 13 years after her death, there were 150 religious centers dedicated to Divine Mercy in Poland. On Divine Mercy Sunday, 2000, Saint Pope John Paul II canonized Saint Faustina. He approved the message of Divine Mercy and declared that the Catholic Church would celebrate the Second Sunday of Easter as "Divine Mercy Sunday".



## ♥ The Power of The Rosary Our Lady's 15 Promises for Praying the Rosary

13. I have obtained from my Divine Son that all the advocates of the Rosary shall have for intercessors the entire Celestial Court during their life and at the hour of death. Since Our Lady is our Advocate, She brings us additional assistance during our life and at our death from all the saints in Heaven (the Communion of Saints). See paragraphs 954 through 959 in the Catechism of the Catholic Church.
14. All who recite the Rosary are my Sons, and brothers of my Only Son Jesus Christ. Since the Rosary is a most excellent prayer focused on Jesus and His Life and activities in salvation history, it brings us closer to Our Lord and Our Lady. Doctrinally, Our Lady is our Mother and Jesus is our Eldest Brother, besides being our God. (see [Lumen Gentium chapter VIII - Our Lady #62](#))
