FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT ~ ~ MARK'S JESUS

Mark's Gospel is the shortest and tersest of all four. The discourses of Jesus tend to be terser as well. Mark's portrayal of Jesus has none of the poetry of the Sermon on the Mount or the Sermon on the Plain as in Matthew or Luke, nor the extensive, reflective "I Am" discourses as in John. Mark's Jesus "cuts to the chase," we would say today. This is reflected quite well in today's passage.

It is no accident that the dialogue of Jesus at this point in the Gospel according to Mark—the concluding words about the end of the world—immediately before his passion, is riddled with exclamation points and an overall sense of urgency.

We would do well to re-tool our own way of living this Advent, for we live in a world urgently in need of hearing the message of Jesus proclaimed. It's time for us to "wake up!" and get out into the world to do it. — Copyright © J. S. Paluch Co.

First Sunday of Advent

Prepare His Way to Come to Us

Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight His paths. — Mark 1:3

What is this kingdom of God that Jesus proclaims? We think immediately of the afterlife: eternal life. Of course it is true that the Kingdom of God will extend without limit beyond earthly life, but the Good News that Jesus brings us is that we do not need to wait for the kingdom of God in the future: it is already at hand. In some way, it is already present, and we may experience power from now on. God comes to establish His Lordship in our history, today, every day, in our lives. Where it is welcomed with faith and humility, there love, joy and peace blossom.

The condition for entering and being part of this kingdom, is to make a change in our life, which is to convert, to convert every day, to take a step forward each day. It is a question of leaving behind the comfortable but misleading ways of idols of this world—success at all costs; power to the detriment of the weak; the desire for wealth; pleasure at any price. Instead, Prepare the way of the Lord! This does not take away our freedom, but gives us true happiness.

With the birth of Jesus in Bethlehem, God Himself abides among us to free us from whatever breaks down our relationship with God and others.

REFLECTION: *What changes in my life do I most want to make this Advent?*

FACTS OF LIFE

Long Beach pro-life apostolate brings hope to pregnant women

It is a cool autumn morning, and Cecilia Chavez is standing where she has stood most weekday mornings for the last 12 years: in front of an abortion clinic. Brochures in hand, and her scapular around her neck, she knows the women entering the building do not want to see her, much less speak with her. Known as the Expectant Mothers Outreach, the apostolate, as it is described, originated at Church of the Holy Innocents in Long Beach. It was a pro-life homily from the parish's pastor, Father Peter Irving, that launched Chavez and a handful of other parishioners into action in 2008. On her first day of actively "reaching out," Chavez persuaded a mother not to abort her twins. "It was emotional," she recalled. Incredible: 1,338 babies' lives have been saved. One of the most crucial aspects of Chavez's work is her partnership with OB/GYN Dr. Patrick Baggot, a board-certified maternal-fetal specialist who has worked with Fr. Irving for many years. This spirit of generosity is the same spirit that shines through Chavez, Fr. Irving, and all of those who support the Expectant Mothers Outreach. www.angelusnews.com

Did You Know?

The devastating effects of verbal abuse

A study by Florida State University found that children who were verbally abused are more likely to experience depression and anxiety. They are also twice as likely to suffer with mood and anxiety disorders throughout their lifetime. Children who suffer such abuse can go on to repeat the same parenting styles they experienced thereby continuing the cycle of abuse. Pay attention to the language you and others use with your children. Breaking the chain of negative behaviors starts with


