THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT ~ ~ The readings this week bear a certain similarity to those of last week—we hear a prophecy from Isaiah that is reiterated by John the Baptist in Mark’s Gospel—but today the focus is different. Last week John told us to repent. Today he is the light leading us to God. Today is also known as “Gaudete (Rejoice) Sunday,” as the reading from First Thessalonians commands us to “Rejoice in the Lord always.” We are to rejoice. Right now. Combined with last Sunday, this seems like a mixed message. “Which is it? Repenting or Rejoicing?” But John is telling us that one leads to the other. As we prepare for the coming of our Savior we must first repent and then rejoice.

FACTS OF LIFE

New children's book, 'When You Became You', aims to educate about life inside the womb.

A new pro-life children's book released on November 10, 2020, aims to teach children the truth that life begins at fertilization. When You Became You, published by Contend Projects co-founders Brooke Stanton and Christiane West, "takes you on a scientific journey through the stages of a human being's life." In an interview with the Daily Caller News Foundation (DCNF), West and Stanton said the colorful book states as "basic fact" that life begins at fertilization, not at birth. "We can have an impact now on elementary school children and long-term impact on the culture, on the crisis of human life," said West. "Having a book that starts them off correctly and hopefully keeps them protected against false information later is part of the goal of this book as well." The pair founded Contend Projects, a "secular, nonpartisan, science education nonprofit with the mission to spread accurate information and awareness about the biological science of human embryology and when a human being begins to exist." After teachers approached them asking for a children's book on this topic, "When You Became You" was born. www.liveaction.org

Did You Know?

Gifts and toys should inspire joy, not cause injuries

Avoid safety hazards while gifting with these tips from the American Academy of Pediatrics and the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission: Toys are age-rated for safety, not for children's intellect and physical ability, so be sure to choose toys in the correct age range; choose toys for children under 3 that do not have small parts that could be choking hazards; for children under 10, avoid toys that must be plugged into an electrical outlet; be cautious about toys that have button batteries or magnets, which can be harmful or fatal if swallowed; and when giving scooters and other riding toys, give the gift of appropriate safety gear, too; helmets should be worn at all times and they should be sized to fit. REASONS TO REJOICE

Saint Paul seems to be throwing out a handful of sayings that may sound overly optimistic, but are actually very practical.

"Rejoice always"? If we pray constantly and thank God for all that happens to us, we have reason to rejoice. Even the things we don't like can be turned to good by God. God allows sin because it leads to forgiveness, an experience of God's love for us. And God allows even death, because God can bring us to eternal life.

When Paul tells us not to quench the Spirit he means we should be open to what the Holy Spirit moves us to do. "Prophetic utterances" refer to things that other people were inspired to proclaim. If we pray constantly (1 Thessalonians 5:17), the distractions of this world will not keep us from hearing the Spirit within us. We won't be so critical of others that we miss what the Spirit is telling us through them.

How do we know if something really is from the Spirit? Saint Paul says, test everything. Retain what is good (1 Thessalonians 5:21). Use the Scriptures, the teachings of the Church, and your conscience to decide whether the Spirit is moving you, or if advice you hear is worthwhile. Trust God to make us holy if we only allow it. Then we will be ready for the coming of the Lord, whether through the sacraments, the celebration of Christmas, or God's final coming in glory. I'd say that's a reason to rejoice.

Wake up to Juan and Mother Mary

Sometimes we forget that God doesn't just love us or our country. God loves every person in the world. One December morning, almost 500 years ago, a man named Juan Diego walked past a rocky hill. Juan was a Nahuatl man, one of the First Peoples of the country we now call Mexico. Juan was one of only a few Nahuatl people to believe in Jesus. That cold morning he saw the vision of a woman whose skin looked just like his. She was dressed like an Aztec princess and spoke to him in his own language. She told him he was the mother of God. Juan believed, and his faith soon brought many of his people to love God, too—the God who loved the poor everywhere and cared for them. To this day, we celebrate Our Lady of Guadalupe to remember this astonishing event in our own part of the world.

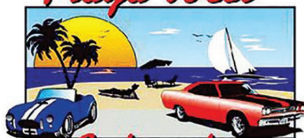
