What was once a secret known only by chosen people like King David and his descendants must now be made clear to all so that, as Saint Paul wrote to the Romans, we can be brought to the "obedience of faith" "according to the command of the eternal God" (Romans 16:26).

FACTS OF LIFE

A November 17 webcast hosted by 40 Days for Life announced the results of the organization's fall 2020 international campaign — its largest 40 Days for Life campaign to date. 40 Days for Life president Shawn Carney noted in an email to supporters on Wednesday that the global event had a record-high 588 vigil sites in 36 countries this fall, including the first-ever vigils held in Cuba and Honduras. In all, 757 babies and their mothers are known to have been saved from the tragedy of abortion, an abortion business closed, and four abortion workers quit as a result of this most recent fall campaign.

During the webcast, Carney shared details on a new initiative being launched on **December 1, called 40 Days for Life 365. "Former workers [...] say that the no-show rate goes as high as 75% in front of a Planned Parenthood [during a 40 Days for Life vigil]," he explained. "That is devastating to the abortion industry, and for years our leaders have been requesting a way to go year-round, for some campaigns to be able to take that extra step and go out and have a peaceful presence throughout the entire year, which devastates the abortion industry. That is how the Planned Parenthood in College Station [Texas] closed over a number of years. That is how other leaders who have been able to do this on a smaller scale have been able to close abortion facilities." www.liveaction.org**

FOURTH SUNDAY OF ADVENT -- PRAY BEFORE YOU SPEAK -- Have you ever been told to "think before you speak"? Nathan seems to have spoken too soon when he told David to do whatever he wanted about building a house for the LORD. But later that night the God gave him a message for David: the LORD did not need anyone to build him a house; God would make David's house (in the sense of family or descendants) last forever. That can be a lesson to us. Instead of just thinking before we speak, it could be a good idea to pray before we speak. How many times have we said something in anger (or selfishness, fear, any strong feeling) that we wished we could take back? If we just think before we speak, we might just rationalize what we wanted to say in the first place. But if you take a little more time to bring our feelings to God, ask for guidance and listen for what God would have us say, things might turn out a lot better. We pray before meals; why not pray before going to work? We can pray before making decisions about our family, getting engaged, taking a new job, buying a new house/car/HD-TV, etc. When a friend or relative needs someone to talk to, we can pray that we listen well and say what God wants our friend to hear. If we have enough faith to let God guide our lives, let's take the time in prayer to listen for that guidance.

Wake up to an Advent Prayer

"The young woman shall name Him Emmanuel." - Isaiah 7:14

Isaiah has another name we Christians use for Jesus—and this name is a prayer. The name is "Emmanuel," which means "God is with us." When we sing *O Come, O Come, Emmanuel*, we are praying to Jesus to come and be with us.

We find another Advent prayer in the Book of Revelation. The prayer is: *"Amen. Come, Lord Jesus."* Long ago, Christian artists would decorate the first letter of a special word with designs. Like this:
