2. PRAY

Ask God what you can do to prepare for Jesus coming at Christmas? Tell God how you will make Jesus visible to the others in your family.

The O Antiphons have been part of Catholic tradition since at least the 5th century. They are prayed during the final days leading to the Christmas celebration.

At the Annunciation, Mary said, "Yes!" to receiving Jesus under the name Emmanuel. The O Antiphons remind us of other names for Jesus.

In these final days preparing for Christmas, take a few minutes to pray the O Antiphon for that day. You can find the short <u>daily prayers</u> <u>here</u>.
