SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME ~ ~ JESUS' WAY ~ ~ Today's readings present a contrast between "Jesus' way" and the "old way." An example of the old way is the law given to Moses and Aaron about leprosy: the leper was unclean and cast out of the community. **Jesus' way is the opposite: the leper is reached out to, touched, and finally cured. Nor ought we think of the "old way" as restricted to the days of Moses and Aaron, or even to the "old" testament. The difference between the old way and Jesus' way arises in our own lives. We still choose, every day, to live in our old way or in Jesus' way. Jesus dared to touch a leper, disregarding the old way. The leper then was changed forever. He felt a calling. He couldn't keep himself from proclaiming that he had been touched by Jesus (even though Jesus told him not to).** Once Jesus touches us, we are called to proclaim his way.

Distribution of Ashes During the Coronavirus
Pandemic (January 15, 2021)

As we enter the holy season of Lent beginning on Ash Wednesday, the question of how ashes will be distributed to the faithful is being addressed by the Congregation for Divine Worship and Discipline of the Sacraments. In a Note (Prot. N. 17/21) issued on January 12, 2021, the Congregation writes: The Priest says the prayer for blessing the ashes. He sprinkles the ashes with holy water, without saying anything. Then he addresses all those present and only once says the formula as it appears in the Roman Missal, applying it to all in general:

**“Repent, and believe in the Gospel”,
or “Remember that you are dust,
and to dust you shall return”.**

The Priest then cleanses his hands, puts on a facemask, and distributes the ashes to those who come to him or, if appropriate, he goes to those who are standing in their places.

The Priest takes the ashes and sprinkles them
on [top of] the head of each
one without saying anything.

Please note that parishes must continue to observe all necessary Liturgical Protocols for the celebration of the Sacraments already in effect.

LENT 2021 - The Catholic Community around the world follows these general regulations during Lent.

ABSTINENCE - Is a penitential practice consisting of restraining from the consumption of meat and is to be observed by all Catholics who are 14 years of age and older. Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and the Fridays during Lent are days of abstinence. Pastors and parents are encouraged to see that children who are not bound by the obligation to fast and abstain are let to appropriate an authentic sense of penance.

FASTING & ABSTINENCE - In addition to abstinence, fasting is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics between the ages of 18-59 years (inclusive). On days of fasting, one full meal is allowed. Two smaller meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may **be taken according to one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal.** Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids are allowed. **NOTE:** If the person is unable to observe above regulations due to ill health or other serious reasons, they are urged to practice forms of self-denial that are suitable to their condition.

FACTS OF LIFE

Lisa Martin is considered a miracle patient. The Georgia mother-of-four was admitted to the hospital in September with COVID-related complications. Her condition deteriorated and the hospital told her family to say goodbye. Against the odds, Martin walked out of the hospital and went home on her way to recovery in December.

For Martin's family members, the experience has also strengthened their faith.

Martin and her husband of 29 years, Jeff, have four adult children, ages 19 to 27.

Martin's daughter Madison said, "Our family has always had a strong Christian faith, but going through this has changed our lives for the better."

The hospital shared, "On Oct. 20, Lisa was comatose, her eyes fixed. The hospital called in her family to say goodbye. They decided to give it 11 days before making a decision about removing her from the ventilator that was breathing for her. But God had other plans. On the eleventh day, Lisa broke through the sedatives and began tracking Jeff with her eyes and she moved her hand." Martin's husband says he hopes his wife's story


will "encourage and help" people facing great difficulties. He said, "I know that doctors can treat patients medically, but healing comes from God." www.texasrighttolife.com
