**SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT ~ ~ HISTORY OF SALVATION ~ ~** The first reading today continues the “history of salvation” narrative that we hear throughout Lent this year. Today’s story was among the best-loved in the Jewish tradition (surely Joseph told the story to young Jesus as he formed him in the ways of their faith); the early fathers of the Church were very fond of it as a means of explaining the sacrifice of Christ on the cross. The overall tone of the first reading, psalm, and second reading seems a little incongruous with the dazzling Gospel, until we remember that the Transfiguration was placed as the Gospel for this Sunday precisely to remind us of the glory that awaits those who live faithfully and obediently to the will of God. In the life of Jesus, it is a preview of the glory of His Resurrection; for us it is a glimpse of the destiny of those who continue, as we heard in last week’s Gospel, to repent and believe in the Good News.

**LENT 2021** - The Catholic Community around the world follows these general regulations during Lent.

**ABSTINENCE** - Is a penitential practice consisting of restraining from the consumption of meat and is to be observed by all Catholics who are 14 years of age and older. Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and the Fridays during Lent are days of abstinence. Pastors and parents are encouraged to see that children who are not bound by the obligation to fast and abstain, are led to appropriate an authentic sense of penance.

**FASTING & ABSTINENCE** - In addition to abstinence, fasting is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics between the ages of 18-59 years (inclusive). On days of fasting, one full meal is allowed. Two smaller meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken **according to one’s needs, but together they should not equal another full meal.** Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids are allowed.

**NOTE:** If the person is unable to observe above regulations due to ill health or other serious reasons, they are urged to practice forms of self-denial that are suitable to their condition.

## Creating Pure Hearts in the Home

### A Lenten Preparation Checklist for Families

#### D. Discuss the Meaning of Fasting

Fasting is an important aspect of the Catholic observation of Lent. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics, aged 18 until age 59. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. Children are not expected or obliged to fast during Lent, and neither are those who are ill or have other extenuating health circumstances. However, many Catholics choose to “give up” something for Lent. This sacrificial practice helps to focus on the important work of Lent: the prayer, penance, and good works that prepare us for Easter. Discuss with your child why we as Catholics fast. Refraining from certain things, limiting our appetites for food, sweets, media, and spending helps us to free up room for God in our lives. Ask your child what is taking up space that God could otherwise have in his or her life. Then share your answer to the same question. Each week, meet as a family to discuss how your fasting or Lenten practices of prayer, penance, and good works are going.


## Second Sunday of Lent You are my delight

## Lent is a time for turning

Lent is a season for turning. As autumn leaves turn and die every year in preparation for the new birth of Spring, so do the followers of Christ turn each Lent, dying to themselves to invite the new life of Easter. It is no accident the season of Lent begins during winter, for the cyclical, “death of life” rhythms of nature mirror the process of rebirth that Lent fosters. The word Lent is itself derived from an Old English word, *lencden*, which means *Spring*. *Turning to God*. Lent is a season for turning to God. It is a time of conversion. ## FACTS OF LIFE

### Spanish Model With Down Syndrome Shows **‘There Are No Barriers If You Have a Dream’**

One girl from Spain is proving that anyone can make their dreams come true, even people like her who were born with Down syndrome. Marian Avila has made a successful career as a model, despite how difficult it can be for people with Down syndrome to find a job. **She is leveraging the media attention she’s received to bring awareness to the chromosomal disorder and encourage people to pursue their dreams no matter what.** As a child, Marian always dreamed of becoming a model. Not only was she born with Down syndrome, she is only 5-foot-3. Her height alone would normally have made it a struggle to attain such a dream. However, she was determined and completed a professional course at a modeling school in 2016. **“I got a letter saying that designer Talisha White wanted me to walk as her ‘celebrity model’ at New York Fashion Week on September 8, 2018,”** Marian shared on her website. **“Finally, finally! I couldn’t stop crying from the emotion. I kept repeating, ‘It’s my dream, it’s my dream.’”** Since then, her career has only escalated. She has appeared in publications such as The New York Times, Vanity Fair, and Vogue. Now, at 23, Marian is the official face of a new campaign by the jean brand Levi. In November 2020, she won a Quincy Jones Exceptional Advocacy Award in recognition of her efforts to champion those who are differently abled. **“I wanted to show the whole world that there are no barriers if you have a dream,”** Marian said. And indeed, she has.


