**FOURTH SUNDAY OF LENT ~ GOD'S MERCY ~** Today's reading from the second book of Chronicles contains a sort of "mini-history" of Israel. It highlights God's mercies in choosing Cyrus the Persian to be an instrument of deliverance when the people were in captivity in Babylon. Despite their sinfulness and the deserved punishment they were undergoing, God's mercy was lavished on the people in the form of a miraculous act of liberation. The Letter to the Ephesians, in much more theological terms, gives a similar account of a God "who brought us to life with Christ—by grace you have been saved." The author stresses that it was when we were "dead in our transgressions" that God saved us, an act of pure grace. He emphasizes that it is not our own efforts that freed us from sin ("this is not from you"); rather, "it is the gift of God." This, of course, is the heart of the entire Pauline corpus, that salvation comes to us by faith in God's mercy, revealed in the death of Jesus.

**LENT 2021** - The Catholic Community around the world follows these general regulations during Lent.  
**ABSTINENCE** - Is a penitential practice consisting of restraining from the consumption of meat and is to be observed by all Catholics who are 14 years of age and older. Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and the Fridays during Lent are days of abstinence. Pastors and parents are encouraged to see that children who are not bound by the obligation to fast and abstain, are led to appropriate an authentic sense of penance.  
**FASTING & ABSTINENCE** - In addition to abstinence, fasting is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics between the ages of 18-59 years (inclusive). On days of fasting, one full meal is allowed. Two smaller meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids are allowed.  
**NOTE:** If the person is unable to observe above regulations due to ill health or other serious reasons, they are urged to practice forms of self-denial that are suitable to their condition.

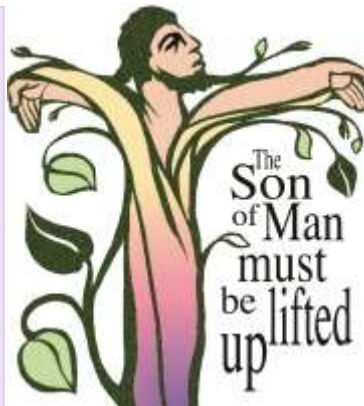

**Saying, Doing, or Being?** St. Paul tells us in his letter to the Ephesians that we are saved through grace: God's actions of sending his Son to die for us, and raising Jesus from the dead show the love God has for us. It comes entirely from God. When Paul says that no one can boast about being saved, he means that we can't add up our good deeds like reward points for heaven. He also means that we can't brag about our faith because we can recite the creed or answer an altar call. So if being saved is not a matter of saying the right things, or doing good deeds, what is it? The answer comes from the gospel. Jesus tells us that he will be lifted up, or crucified, so that we can believe in him and have eternal life. When we "believe in" someone, we put our love and trust in that person.



We know that we are loved and so respond by giving love. Our response of love inspires us to stop being selfish and start noticing that others need our help. Jesus describes it as living in the light: we are not ashamed to help someone, forgive someone, or comfort someone. That brings us back to the question about salvation: it is not something we do or say. It is what God does for us. Our response of faith is also his gift. So when we recognize all that God has done for us and believe in his Son Jesus, the Spirit will guide us to live that faith and share it with others.

## FACTS OF LIFE

### **Pressured to Abort: One Mother's Heroic Journey**

During the second trimester of Marissa's third pregnancy, doctors discovered a tumor in her brain called Glioblastoma. This is one of the deadliest, most aggressive types of cancer. The life expectancy is 12 to 14 months, with fewer than three to seven percent of people surviving longer than five years. Marissa was only 30 years old and otherwise healthy. The doctors told her she would need to begin treatment immediately for any hope of survival. Encouraged to have an abortion in her second trimester, Marissa refused. She knew the risks, but abortion was never an option for her. On August 18, 2019, weighing in at 2 lb. 3 oz. and 14.25 inches long, a beautiful baby girl named Victoria Lee was born. Victoria would spend 83 days in the NICU before being released to go home. She hoped to teach others that sacrificial love is not an act to be viewed as a burden, but as something beautiful. Marissa fought valiantly to the very end. She desperately wanted to live. But, on Feb., 2, 2021, Marissa said her final goodbyes to her family and three small children. She lived with no regret about the decision she'd made. She was buried on her 32<sup>nd</sup> birthday. There will undoubtedly come a day when her daughter, Victoria, will learn about the willing sacrifice her mother made. She'll never have to daydream about heroes like Superman or a Prince. ## Fourth Sunday of Lent How God Treats Failures?

We should remember how God chose to deal with the failures of this world: "God so loved the world that He gave His only Son, so that everyone who believes in Him may not perish but have eternal life. 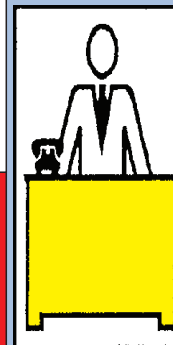
