

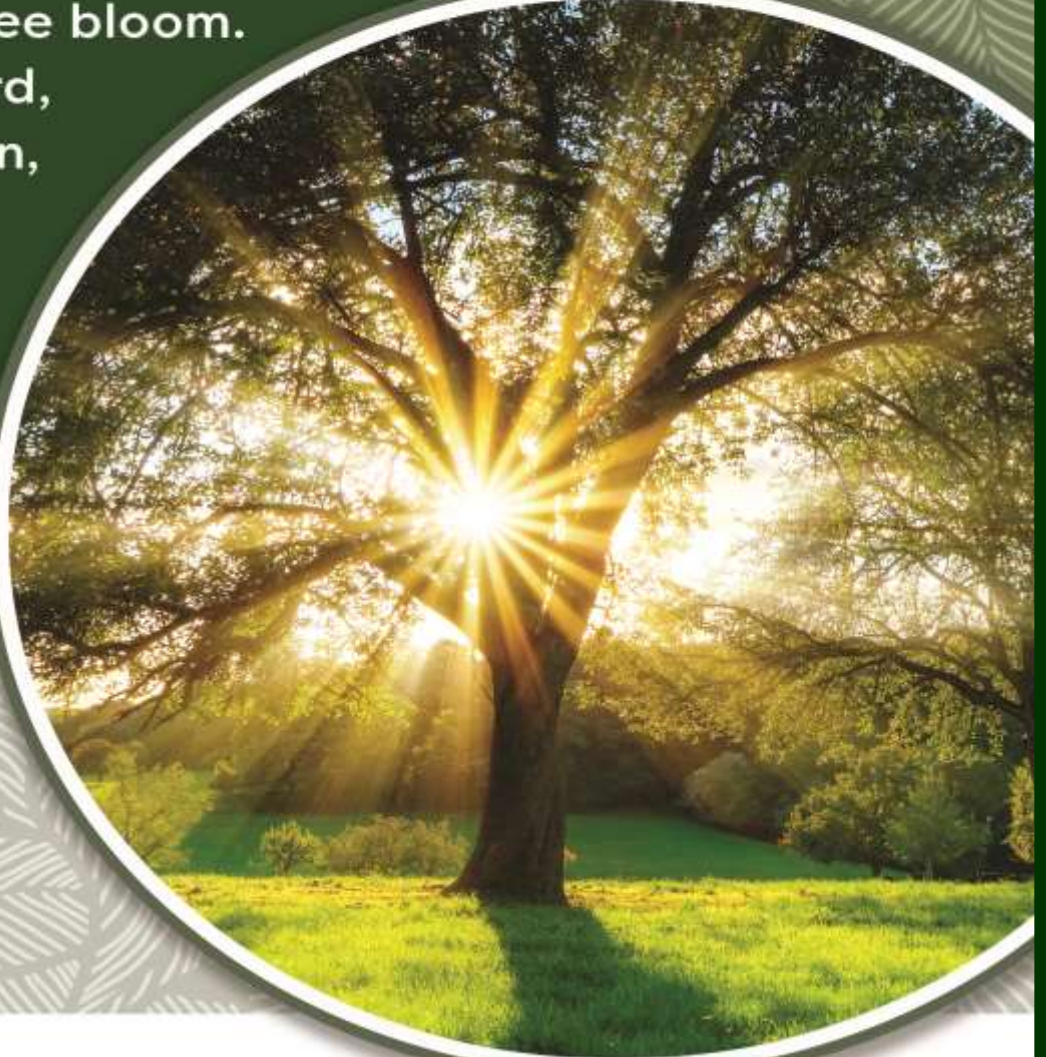

ELEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME ~ ~ GOD'S TIME ~ ~ We either pay attention to or ignore "clock time" as we play in the summer sun and note the earth's tilt and the lengthening days. We live by time. We reckon time in seconds and minutes and hours, or we use broader chunks like supertime and summertime. God keeps another sort of time. God speaks to us of "saving time," that is, the time of salvation. This sense of time is called kairos, and this time is always now, always present and available, always revealing, often surprising. This Sunday's readings alert us to the reality and the import of God's time. Ezekiel and the Gospel of Mark remind us that our labor and our plotting and our planning rest in God. For God takes our smallest efforts and makes of them great works. Paul points us to the "harvest" time, urges us to be watchful for its coming, and calls us to recognize that we must spend our time pleasing God. ~ ~ Copyright © J. S. Paluch Co.

Did You Know?

Avoiding sexting and building healthy relationships

When teens start dating, they often feel pressure to keep up with their peers and to explore new romantic feelings. But these feelings, combined with teenage hormones and decision-making capabilities, can lead to some poor choices, including sexting. Sending nude images is dangerous and puts the sender and the receiver at risk. Photos can be shared instantly on cell phones and social media, and once out there, the images never go away. Talk to your teen about the consequences of sexting and the importance of building healthy relationships where partners respect boundaries and don't ask for explicit images. FACTS OF LIFE ~ ~ Noah, born with just 2% of his brain, shows that anything is possible after surgery to allow him to walk and play football

A nine-year-old boy born with just two percent of his brain is hoping to be able to walk and play football for the first time after undergoing a five-hour operation to straighten his legs. Noah Wall, from Carlisle in England, was diagnosed with spina bifida — a paralyzing condition resulting from the baby's spine failing to connect in the womb. Doctors told Noah's parents, Michelle and Rob, that he was unlikely to ever talk, walk or eat on his own, since he was to be born missing much of his brain due to a porencephalic cyst in his head. His loving parents revealed how they were asked five times to consider aborting him. They refused. Luckily for little Noah, his parents chose to give him life, and, nine years later, he has exceeded doctors' expectations and grown into a "brilliant young man". His brain has grown to eighty per cent, and his humor has blossomed too. Relentlessly positive, Noah has said: "I want to run first, and then I want to walk. One day I want to play football and score goals, I think that would be exciting.

ST. ROBERT'S CENTER IN VENICE NEEDS VOLUNTEERS

The center provides emergency food for residents of Santa Monica, Venice, LAX Airport, West Los Angeles, Beverly Hills, and Culver City areas. The center has a rotating schedule of six parishes who commit to having volunteers come, and St. Anastasia has been one of these parishes. The center operates from 7:30 to 11:30 a.m. making sandwiches to distribute in lunch bags, giving out groceries and donated clothes, and just being present with those who need a human connection. The center reserved June 26, August 7, October 30 and December 11 just for St. Anastasia volunteers and we ask you kindly to consider volunteering at the Center one of these days.
