Using the “What If” game to raise problem-solving children

The “What If” game is a great way to walk your children through potential scenarios, and work with them to find the best solutions. Andrea Bocelli shares song in honor of mother
who refused doctors' advice to abort him

In 2010 Bocelli released several inspirational videos in which he described his mother's brave defiance of doctors' advice to abort him, and praised her for making “the right choice,” and saying other mothers should take encouragement from the story. In a video, the singer tells the audience a story about a young pregnant wife hospitalized for what medics assume is appendicitis.

“The doctors had to apply some ice on her stomach and when the treatments ended the doctors suggested that she abort the child. They told her it was the best solution because the baby would be born with some disability”.

He went on, “But the young brave wife decided not to abort, and the child was born. That woman was my mother, and I was the child. Maybe I’m partisan, but I can say that it was the right choice”.

He said he hoped the story could encourage many mothers in “difficult situations” but who want to save the life of their unborn child.


