1. HEAR

2. PRAY

Re-read the Gospel passage. Use your imagination to pray with the Gospel.

Close your eyes and picture the room in Jairus' home. Imagine that you are Jairus' daughter.

Share with us how you are living out your faith at home. Use #LACatholicsBelieve and tag @LACatholics on social media.

You are lying in bed, seriously ill. Pay attention to how you are feeling, and what you are thinking. What is happening around you? What do you hear? Imagine that Jesus comes into the room. What do you feel as he touches you? What does Jesus say to you? What do you say to Jesus?



Thank Jesus for this time together. Tell him what you need from him right now. Listen for his response.

Close your prayer by slowly praying the Our Father.

3. TALK

Take a moment to think back on all the months of the pandemic.

When did it feel like part of you was dying? Describe that experience. How do you feel about this now? What healing do you still need?

After each person shares, reach out to them and either touch their shoulder, hold their hand or give them a hug, while saying: "Do not be afraid; just have faith."
