1. HEAR

2. PRAY

Put yourself in the shoes of one the apostles from today's Gospel:

- How would you feel if Jesus called you today?
- Where do you think Jesus would send you?

- What would you say to Him?
- Take a moment of silence to talk with Jesus.
- Conclude this moment of prayer by saying "Jesus, I trust you" three times.

3. TALK

As a family, discuss the following questions:

- Share with your family about what you talked about with Jesus. What did He tell you and where do you think He is sending you today?
- We can be missionaries within our own neighborhood. Based on your conversation with Jesus and where He is asking you to go, think about what you would really need to take with you.
- As a family, make a list of people you could contact this week (by email, phone, video call, postal mail).
- Jesus sent people out in twos. Consider doing the activities from the previous bullet point with a friend or family member.
