God's Laws

Today's readings provide some interesting parallels and contrasts. The first reading is an account of Moses who, having delivered the Law to the Israelites, admonishes them to "observe them [its statues] carefully." The author of the Letter of James, likewise, instructs fellow Christians to "welcome the word," they have received, that they may become "doers of the words and not hearers only." The psalmist praises "whoever walks blamelessly and does justice," by listing a few examples of what is required for that descriptions that apply equally to both Jewish and Christian traditions. On the other hand, when the scibes and Pharisees point out that the disciples have not properly washed their hands before eating (which is, as Mark explains, the usual Jewish practice) Jesus scolds them sharply for being too focused on human rules even ritual ones - instead of God's laws.

DOERS OF THE WORD

Today's text offers important advice for Christians of every generation. God is first cited as the author of all gifts, and in particular, reference is made to the gift of Baptism, by which, we have been made the "first fruits" of the new creation.

What follows is advice based on a very Jewish understanding of the "word" as an active force, operative in the world. We are reminded that unless we, too, become "doers" of the word, our claim to faith is empty. Today, and in subsequent weeks, the author reminds us that it is equally important to do the "works" of love, for example, by caring for the "orphans and widows in their affliction."

When Joel Wegener's daughter, Mary Kate, told him that her dream was to work with him, the devoted dad of 10 did his best to make it happen. With his two adult children, who have Down syndrome, Wegener founded "Special Neat Treats" in the spring of 2021.

The siblings and their dad are doing the rounds of their neighborhood bringing much-needed cheer and ice cream to their community. And in fact, the desserts are such a success, the family has sold nearly 5,000 ice cream treats to date.

"It's about an experience for everybody, but to give my kids something to do and show other parents maybe there is something creative, out of the box that we can come up for our family and for our kids to do," shared Wegener, in an interview, as reported by the Le Jeune Foundation.

And their efforts are far-reaching. Not only are they giving their community a chance to lend their support, the Wegeners are also inspiring other families in their community, who may be facing similar challenges with their children.

For Josh and Mary-Kate, they're delighted to work alongside their dad. He's taught them the essentials of customer service, as well as giving them the opportunity to gain some independence, in the comfort of a family business.

The family is now looking to expand the business by adding more trucks to their fleet, and spreading even more awareness and delicious sweet treats.
