## Try these tips to get your children talking about their days

Ever been met with silence when you ask, "How was your day?" Your communication efforts with your children, especially school-age children, may need some tweaking. Try asking concrete questions, like "Who did you sit next to at lunch?" or, "What was the most interesting thing you learned today?" If your child is struggling with sharing his or her emotions, it might be helpful to ask about other emotions you see around you. Find opportunities to get children talking about how they feel by focusing on other people: "Why do you think that girl and her dad are hugging? What made that boy on the playground mad earlier?" In this week's Gospel, John the Baptist was in the desert preaching a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sin. Various groups of people who had gone out to hear John preach, asked him, "What should we do?" When they hear John's answers, they wonder if he is the Messiah they had been expecting. John assures them he is not the Messiah, but that the Messiah is coming.

On this Third Sunday of Advent, we too are waiting expectantly for the coming of the Messiah. Slowly read the Gospel again.






